We often hit many bumps in road like injuries, trauma, fear, stress, disconnection etc.

This master class is designed to educate you on a higher level by offering a hands-on comprehensive holistic approach offering you the opportunity to learn anatomy & biomechanics through a whole horse dissection and complement this with practical classical training and rehabilitation skills. Although issues are mostly hidden in a deep place, we're often able to see and feel them from the outside. When you pay attention to these details, you'll be able to discover a treasure of information right under your eyes. During this module you'll make a journey through the life story of the horse and learn to read it 'inside-out'. The facts will be unravelled before your eyes and you're allowed to feel everything to develop a better understanding of this fascinating being 'horse'.



The dissection will have a very interactive nature with an entire team of specialists – a licensed vet, a dentist and a bodyworker - ready to answer all your questions and to perform practicals with you, including the effect of several bridles, bits and saddles on locomotion of the horse.

Topics that will be covered are: • Fascia • Muscle layers and their function and connections • Joints and attachment of muscles • Tendons and ligaments • Veins • Head, hyoid and nerves • Lymph nodes • Vertebrae's • Organs • Tack influence on movement

An extensive manual of 120 pages will be provided for. On top, a professional photographer will make beautiful pictures that of all-important structures and findings will be provided for free after the module.

As we strongly believe that you need to know what feel/look for, you'll get the opportunity to work with Thirza's schooled professor horses who can give you the right feeling for all different stages of training. They all have a wide variety of significant biomechanical 'abnormalities' ranging from C6/C7 malformation to past fractures.

You will be guided to train your senses –eye, feel, smell, hearing - to perform a proper biomechanical assessment in movement and standstill (palpation).

Furthermore, the horses will be able to show you the power and lightness of correct training and balance for each individual horse. During the master class you'll be taken on a realistic journey showing you the many bumps on the road you might encounter, but also showing you how to overcome or manage them in a way that empowers both you and the horse. Exercises will range from straight lines – high school movements, with the emphasis on not performing exercises for the exercise, but as a means to a better end in which both participant and horse find true enjoyment, balance through rewiring muscle memory and lightness.

This experience will inspire you in your own personal journey, give you the opportunity to practise your assessment skills and at the same to get the right feel and essence of all the exercises so you can transfer this back to your own horse(s) back home aiming to achieve an optimal mental and physical well-being for your horse(s) improving both your relationship and performance in harmony and balance.

MEALS

TRANSPORTATION

Travelling through The Netherlands is very easy. There are 2 airports close to the venue:

Eindhoven Airport (30 min from venue)

Schiphol Airport (1.15 hours from venue)

Eindhoven airport only does (low fare) European flights, Schiphol airport is the main airports for global flights.

To get from the airport to the venue it is most convenient to use the Dutch public transit. Taxi's are very expensive and the public transit is very easy and most used way of traveling in The Netherlands. Don't worry if you're not used to it in your country, you'll be guided through.

If you arrive at Schiphol Airport:

You can take a direct train from Schiphol Airport to 's Hertogenbosch (1.04 hours). The train leaves every 15 mins and costs arounds €10-15 single way.

Once you've arrived at 's Hertogenbosch, you can either choose to get a connecting bus that stops right in front of the venue (15 min) or get a taxi (10min)

If you arrive at Eindhoven Airport:

You can take a taxi to the venue (30 min)

Please email your flight numbers and a detailed schedule of the trains will be send to you. If more people arrive around the same time, a joint taxi will be reserved at a lower fare. If anyone needs special assistance, make sure to email on time!
